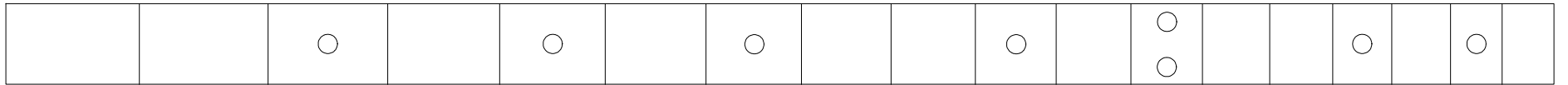


Concert Ukulele Fret Layout (standard 15" scale length)

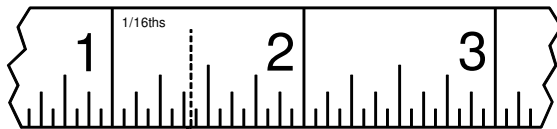

Note: Basic units of measurement are indicated by the english fractional system. Measurements are also indicated in millimeters, and the user will need to adjust material and tooling sizes to match geographic conventions. All dimensions can be transferred directly from this full size drawing.

" My tape measure looks like this, how do I measure to a 64th inch?"



Split the distance between the 16th inch divisions for 32nd inch measurements, example 1-13/32"

Split this "visualized" 1/32" distance again for 64th inch measurements, example 1-25/64"

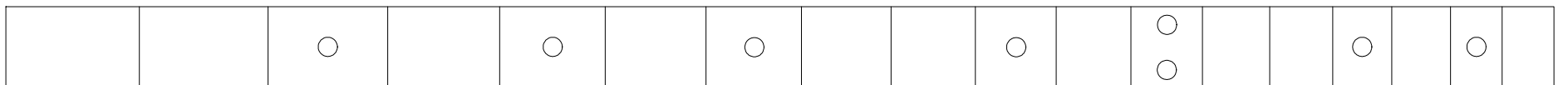
Printing note:

PDF printing is very accurate if your print settings are selected correctly. Make certain that your particular "print dialog" box is selected for "no scaling". Verify the outer border is printed exactly to 10" by 7" (254 by 177.8).
