“FD—>” indicates a finger drag where the finger plays both the beat and offbeat in an eight-note pair by “dragging” across the strings.

Chords/chord changes above the tab lines (boldfaced letters) are those used for playing backup guitar, or chording on the banjo.

Capo two for playing in D minor. The three chords would be Dm, F, and C.

Capo four for playing in E minor. The three chords would be Em, G, and D.
